Basic

- Reflects little or no comprehension of reading done in simulation
- Shows disorganization and/or repetition
- Does not use story techniques; fails to capture the reader's imagination
- Uses few, if any, details
- Lacks a resolution or provides a disorganized resolution
- Includes errors in grammar, mechanics, and spelling that interfere with the understanding of the narrative

Proficient

- Reflects adequate comprehension of reading done in simulation
- Shows organization of ideas into a general story structure
- Uses some story techniques to capture the reader's imagination
- Provides some supporting details that develop ideas in the narrative
- Provides a resolution
- Demonstrates an understanding of grammar, mechanics, and spelling

Advanced

- Reflects full comprehension of reading done in simulation
- Uses compelling language and cohesive organization of ideas in a clear story structure
- Makes excellent use of story techniques to capture the reader's imagination
- Provides varied supporting details that develop the ideas in the narrative
- Completes narrative with a well-planned resolution
- Effectively uses grammar, mechanics, and spelling to enhance meaning
