damage	V.	to harm or injure (damages, damaging, damaged)
disaster	n.	a sudden event that causes a lot of harm or damage
first responder	n. phr.	a person (especially a police officer or an EMT) who goes immediately to the scene of an emergency to help
gazebo	n.	a small building, usually in a park, that is open on all sides
generator	n.	a machine that produces electrical energy
Haitian Creole	n.	a French-based language, commonly spoken in Haiti (also called Creole)
mobilize	V.	to bring people together for action (mobilizes, mobilizing, mobilized)
search party	n. phr.	an organized group of people looking for someone or something that is missing
survivor	n.	someone who continues to live after something very dangerous has happened
task force	n. phr.	a group of people brought together to solve specific problems
