### Strategy Suggestion

Ask questions calling for an answer that will show knowledge of a word's meaning:

- **Q:** What type of *damage* might a hurricane cause?
- **A:** fallen trees, no electricity, flooded basements, broken windows

Word/Term	Part of Speech	Definition
<b>damage</b>	v.	to harm or injure (damages, damaging, damaged)
<b>disaster</b>	n.	a sudden event that causes a lot of harm or damage
<b>first responder</b>	n. phr.	a person (especially a police officer or an EMT) who goes immediately to the scene of an emergency to help
<b>gazebo</b>	n.	a small building, usually in a park, that is open on all sides
<b>generator</b>	n.	a machine that produces electrical energy
<b>Haitian Creole</b>	n.	a French-based language, commonly spoken in Haiti (also called Creole)
<b>mobilize</b>	v.	to bring people together for action (mobilizes, mobilizing, mobilized)
<b>search party</b>	n. phr.	an organized group of people looking for someone or something that is missing
<b>survivor</b>	n.	someone who continues to live after something very dangerous has happened
<b>task force</b>	n. phr.	a group of people brought together to solve specific problems
