Word/Term	Part of Speech	Definition
Haiti	n.	a country on an island in the West Indies in the Caribbean Sea
handler	n.	a person who trains or has charge of an animal, especially a dog
housing share	n. phr.	an arrangement in which two or more unrelated people share a house or an apartment (housing shares)
rescuer	n.	a person who saves someone from a dangerous situation (rescuers)
rubble	n.	pieces of broken brick, stone, or concrete from fallen building or walls
victim	n.	a person who is hurt, suffers from, or is killed by a person, object, or event (victims)
