Episode 5: Not It

Strategy Suggestion

There are four **open compound words** in this list: *action plan*; *case meeting*; *post-traumatic stress*; and *personal history*. Explain that the first word of an open compound is usually an adjective or noun, but that both words together make a noun with a meaning that is different from that of the individual words. Discuss the meaning of the open compounds on this list. Ask students to suggest open compounds they know.

Word/Term	Part of Speech	Definition
action plan	n. phr.	a plan of steps, resources, and the time frame needed to reach a given goal
anti-anxiety	adj.	having to do with preventing or easing anxiety
anxiety	n.	a state of mind in which someone is fearful or nervous about what might happen
asthma	n.	a health problem that makes it difficult for someone to breathe
case meeting	n. phr.	a meeting in which coworkers discuss how to handle the case of a particular client they might all know or have in common
complaint	n.	a statement made by someone who is unhappy or dissatisfied with something (complaints)
condition	n.	a usually bad state of physical or mental health (conditions) e.g., She has a heart <i>condition</i> for which she regularly sees a doctor.
evict	v.	to force someone to leave a rented home (evicts, evicting, evicted)
intake	adj.	having to do with the act or process of taking something in, such as information about a person
landlord	n.	a person who owns a house, apartment, etc., and rents all or part of it to other people
post-traumatic stress	n. phr.	a group of mental or emotional symptoms, such as depression or anxiety, that can affect someone who has had a very shocking or difficult experience
wound	n.	a cut or other injury to a part of the body
